- To ensure buildings and grounds are in good order and safe for all, as well as actively developing them so they are missionally fit for purpose.
- Ensure the church is well resourced to worship God and develop people spiritually as a priority and that all funds are used missionally.
- PCCs are *not there* to receive complaints. If any concerns arise they, with several possible solutions, should be communicated to the priest who will consider further.
