FIRST AID AND ACCIDENTS AT ST GILES' CHURCH

A new first aid kit has been placed in the vestry. Underneath it are two accident books. One of these is for recording actual accidents. The other is a 'near miss' book, for recording accidents that didn't quite happen. An example might be a slip in the pulpit whilst changing the hymn numbers, but the individual grabs the pulpit side and saves themselves from falling. Please record any accidents or near misses happening in the church building or churchyard in the appropriate book. Please also inform one of the wardens if an accident happens. Contact details are on the accident book. 'Near misses' will be reviewed by the wardens and the parish priest periodically. The same system is in operation in the church hall, looked after by Sara Dyott, to whom accidents there should be reported.

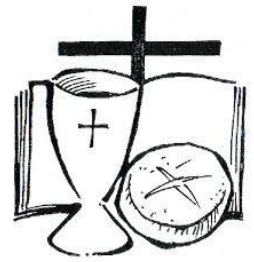
