THESE are two impropriated Parishes, Co. *Stafford*, which give Title to this Prebend, which is rated for first Fruits at 13 *l.* 6. *s.* 8. *d.* The Prebendary is Patron of *Berkswych* Donative, but not of *Whittington* Vicaridge, as I conceive.

* HUGH *de Sotesby*, as I judge, held it about 1268.

JOHN *de Monte-Majore*, was succeeded in it *An.* 1298. by

THOMAS *de Adderbury*, 16 *Cal. Martii.* 1298. he was 1303. made Precentor.

JOHN *de Drakesford* was collated to it 12 *Cal. Feb.* 1303.

GUYDO *de Wares* succeeded *Drakesford* 1309.

* ROBERT *de Kitsbe*, was collated to it *Aug.* 16. 1340.

RICHARD *de Drayton*, was admitted *Feb.* 26. 1388.

THOMAS BENNET, admitted *Feb.* 14. 1405. he exchanged it with

RALPH CANON, *May* 13. 1406. he exchanged it with

JOHN COLE, *Dec.* 15. 1420. he died 1433.

JOHN BRIDE, Archdeacon of *Derby*, was admitted *May* 8. 1433. on *Cole's* Death.

EDMUND HALSE, was collated *May* 22. 1478. on *Bride's* Death, and quitted it for *Eccleshall*.

CHRISTOPHER TALBOT, was admitted *April* 11. 1481. and was 1482. made Archdeacon of *Chester*, and succeeded by

HUMPHREY HAWARDEN, *LL. B.* collated *June* 6. 1482. He was afterwards Prebend of *Tervin*.

HUGH LEHEE, was admitted *Dec.* 18. 1488. and died 1502.

RICHARD EGERTON, *A. B.* was admitted *Oct.* 5. 1506. and died 1537. being Rector of *Endseild*, and Canon of this Church.

JOHN STAPULTON, succeeded, being admitted *April* 12. 1538.

ROBERT BELL, was admitted *Fan.* 21. 1550. as was

WILLIAM WALKEDEN, admitted *Aug.* 27. 1558. and

THOMAS PAGET, admitted *March* 15. 1559. He occurs posses'd of it about 1590.

WILLIAM WHITING, was admitted *May* 25. 1610. as was

JOSEPH HILL, *B. D.* admitted *Aug.* 1. 1617.

THOMAS TUDMAN, *A. M.* was admitted *Aug.* 9. 1639. He was Vicar of *Sandback*, Co. *Chester*, and died about 1674.

THOMAS MEYNELL, *A. M.* succeeded, being admitted *July* 29. 1476. He died 1706. being Rector of *Church Langley* Co. of *Derby*.

THOMAS COLLINS, *A. M.* succeeded, being collated *Nov.* 1. 1706. He died 1722. at *Oxford*, where he was Master of *Magdalen* College School, and was buried in *Magdalen* College Chapel. His Successor was

JOHN HENRY OTT, presented by the Archbishop on his Option *March* 12. 1722-3.

WOLVEY.

WAS founded by Bishop *Muscamp*, and consists of a Moiety or one half of the Impropriation and Advowson of *Wolvey* Co. *Warwick*, and is rated at 2 *l.* 3 *s.* 4 *d.* for first Fruits, *An.* 1534. 26. *Henry* 8.

JAMES *de Hispana* resigned it 1314. and was succeeded by GILBERT *de Bruera*, 6 *Cal. Nov.* 1314. He chang'd it for *Ruilton*, with

RALPH *de Holbeck*, 19 *Cal. April* 1331.

MICHAEL *de Northburgh*, was collated 17 *Cal. Oct.* 1342. He changed it 1353. for *Flixton*, with

PETER *de Northburgh*, 2 *Non. April* 1353.

JOHN BARNET was collated 12 *Cal. May* 1354. He changed it for the Archdeaconry of *London*, with

JAMES BEAUFORT, 5 *Id. Feb.* 1355.

RICHARD *de Stafford* was collated to it, 2 *Non. June* 1358. As was

WILLIAM *de Lambe*, collated 9 *Cal. Aug.* 1369.

THOMAS ALABLASTER held it 1374.

JOHN MAUREWARD, was admitted *July* 27. 1387. He chang'd it for the Chancellorship with

JOHN FELTWELL, who was admitted *May* 17. 1393. As was RICHARD CONINGSTON, *May* 20. 1393. He quitted it for *Hansacre*. and was succeeded by

THOMAS ALCOCK, admitted *March* 6. 1393. He resigned it, and was succeeded by

THOMAS MIDDLETON, *June* 1. 1394. He resigned it, and was succeeded by
